- Impart knowledge of this church and its wider ministry through distribution of its periodicals and other publications
- 4. Endeavor to increase the support given by the congregation to the work of the church-wide organization of the LCMC.

- 2. Strong communication skills with visitations, phone calling, one-on-one contact, and personal meetings.

Greetings from Ohio in the name of Jesus Christ!

We are now in the quest for a new pastor. We know that God has been preparing our next leader, and we are excited to meet whomever He sends. Perhaps that is you!

We are a small and stable country church, founded in 1841. We are located in the middle of a farming community, 83 miles South from Cleveland, 20 miles Southwest of Youngstown, and 67 miles Northwest of Pittsburgh. We are in the South Range School District whose High School is a National Blue Ribbon School. Our area is poised to grow due to the proximity to Youngstown and the increasing presence of major companies.

Our mission is to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ as it is revealed through Holy Scripture, our Lutheran heritage and our hope for the future. We have one Sunday service at 10:30 am with an average attendance of 65, more on festival Sundays. The service is a traditional liturgical service from the LBW and we use the Revised Common Lectionary. Holy Communion is normally celebrated on the first and third Sundays of the month as well as festival Sundays.

As our congregation ages, fewer young persons are attending. This is our most pressing concern. Our hope is that our new shepherd will partner with us to follow the Great Commission; draw more young families into our fold; minister to our faithful core of existing members; and bring Word and Sacrament to our home-bound.
